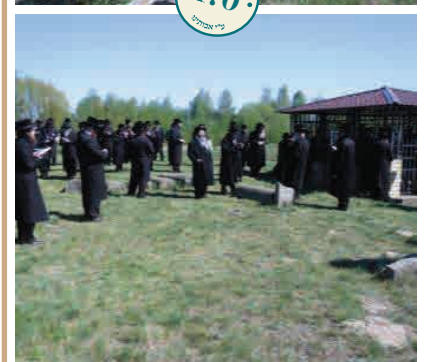
The new pathway alongside the gate is now complete, enabling
to reach the אוהל. During renovations the original plans
needed to be modified since the planned pathway was too low
and would be ruined by rainfall flowing from the mountainous
terrain. Therefore, the following necessary steps were taken: The
entire pathway was raised to higher ground level – A drainage
ditch was dug at the bottom of the mountain – A smaller ditch
was installed at the end of the first one – In case of heavy rains
the excess water will be redirected to the large garden behind the
guard's house. 25 tons of gravel was used to form a stable
base, the path was expanded to 1.5 meters wide and geo-textile
was placed underneath the gravel to avoid overgrowth. The end
result: a durable, clean and secure pathway ready for use by the
numerous visitors for many years to come.
