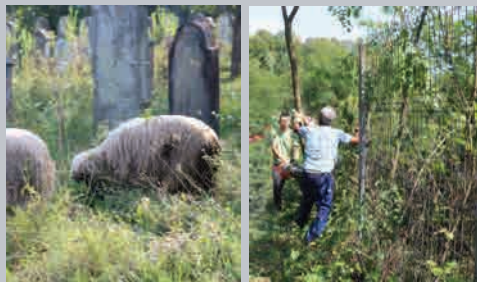


New tombstone discovered during clean-up of the cemetery
