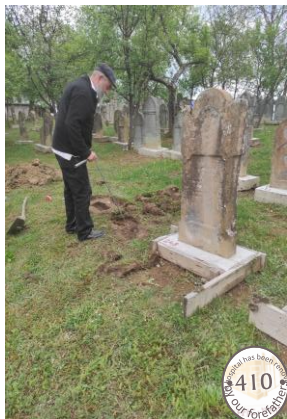
Synever, Ukraine

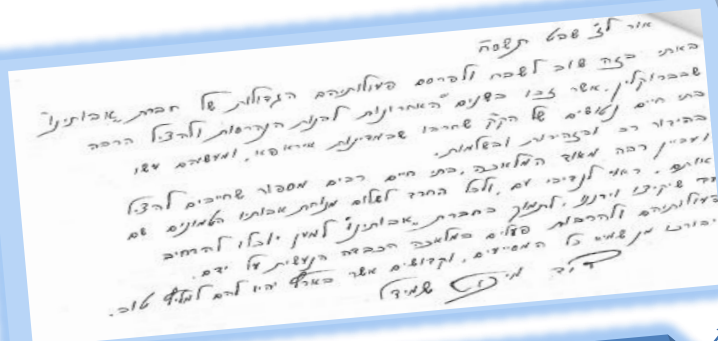
