Short overview of the activities in the cemetery:

A) Evaluation year 2012:

Historic discovery: Avoyseinu representatives led by R' Chaim Refoel Ferencz and R' Shmil Szabó discover the Matzeiva of Mrs. Leah Perl a"h, mother of the Saraf, on its original spot. Fragments of a matzeiva, possibly of the Saraf, discovered nearby.

B) Fence constsruction year 2012:

Beautiful fence around the entire cemetery, resting site of illustrious and pious tzadikim of Kozhnitz, Mogielnica and Lizhensk completed be"H. Fervent preparations underway for the construction of the ohel.

C) Discovery of resting site of the Saraf year 2012:

After the war, the resting site of Saraf remained hidden from Klal Yisroel. After much research, the base of the matzeiva has been discovered, firmly rooted to the ground in an original position. Yidden flock to the sacred resting site to daven and light candles.

D) Foundation for ohel year 2014:

Foundation is poured for the ohel of the Saraf, in attendance of the Spinka Rebbe shlit"a. The foundations are set on the original frame of the ohel, under close supervision of HFPJC representatives. Plans for the ohel's structure is further prepared.

E) Ohel be"H year 2015:

Sketch for the ohel is finalized as HFPJC agents prepare the project for launching be"H.


