
Project preparations - Summer 2014

Short notes of the successful trip in preparation of the upcoming projects

- **Ukraine:** HFPJC members first arrived to **Kolomaya**, a cemetery project that is followed closely by relatives and Jews worldwide, to finalize and approve several details necessary of the completion of the fence in the middle cemetery, and intervene for the restoration of the old cemetery. The intervention proceeded successfully, and HFPJC hopes to commence work shortly be"H.
- Afterward, HFPJC met with the chief Ukrainian contractor to discuss how to proceed with the work in the cemeteries in **Bialy Kamien, Delatin** and **St. Miklos**, all of which have been continuously delayed due to various reasons. The positive conference raised hopes that the project will progress successfully be"H. At the same time, HFPJC received the joyful news that material for the fence in **Oliksandrivka** has been delivered to the site.
- **Slovakia:** Wednesday, HFPJC members were in Slovakia where intensive negotiations were taken up to advance the several projects that have been halted due to bureaucratic reasons. HFPJC contacted the mayors in **Stranany, Radvan** and **Gajdos** and created positive contact with a promise for continued cooperation in carrying through the project.
- HFPJC then met with a neighbor of the **Stropkov** cemetery to negotiate a compromise so that the cemetery can be properly fenced despite disputes on property ownership.
- **Poland:** Thursday, on the way to the airport, HFPJC members sprang into **Fryszak** where they deepened the contacts previously created with the contractor for upcoming Polish projects.

• HFPJC board members returned from the successful trip with hopes to continue and complete the cemetery restorations without further delay.


