As the first phase in each restoration project, a cemetery evaluation is a wide-ranging process. We have therefore set forth the evolvement of this mission, completed in about 300 cemeteries to date.

A Concerned descendants contact the HFPJC to inquire upon the condition of their ancestral cemetery.

B After necessary preparation, an agent from the HFPJC travels down to personally assess the cemetery.

C HFPJC agents synchronize pre-war and current maps to ascertain accurate borders.

D HFPJC reps gauge cemetery ground to ensure exact borders. When needed, expert surveying equipment is utilized.

F In addition to the standard assessment form, a detailed presentation is created and released for the larger projects.
