Current wire fencing is in extremely poor condition and not on original borders; gravestones had been left outside. A 349m fence is urgently needed to enclose unprotected cemetery; neighbor's wall around his private house, which is built on the cemetery grounds on lot #159, comprises the remaining 77m.

Problems:

On the western side, a 30x3 m support wall needed. There might be simpler solution: filling it up with earth. Need to further discuss with engineer. Approx. 200 m of fence can be done with deep, continuous footing (may entail extra construction costs.)
